What is Ageism?

Ageism is a stereotyping, prejudice, and discrimination against individuals based on their age. The prejudices can lead to discrimination against the needs of older adults. It can manifest itself in multiple ways; health care, housing, social services, media representation, and policy decisions. Examples of these are:

- Social Situations
 - Speaking in patronizing tones to elders using terms like “sweetheart, dear, young lady
 - Jokes and comments about age, such as “you are too old for this”, or “you are a dinosaur”.
- Medical Situations
 - Dismissing medical concerns as “normal,” you are just getting old.
 - Undertreatment, providing less aggressive or curative treatment to older patients, assuming they are too fragile
 - Assumptions that older patients can’t understand their own treatment and direct all questions to caregivers.

Older adults can also limit themselves by believing they are “too old” to learn new technology or start a new fitness routine, or change jobs.

Families and facilities need to meet the basic needs of the older population. This includes not taking financial advantage of their money. We can counteract these injustices through public education, reporting reform, and age-friendly services.

We need to cultivate a culture that honors the rights and dignity of all ages of life. Seniors need to be part of this process.

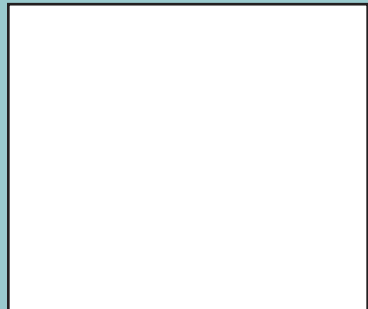

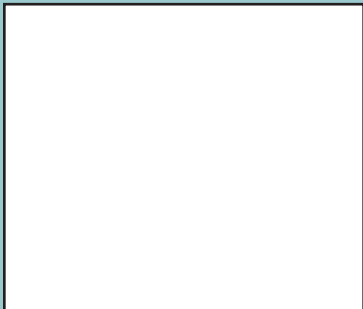
